

Napa



In Napa, look for local wine, olive oil, herbs, honey, and cheese.

Napa County is characterized by dry hot summers and dozens of different soil types—from gravelly loams to silty clay—crosscut with streams, rivers and stands of Madrone and Live Oak trees. The county's hot dry summers ripen its famous grapes, while the cooling breezes of the county's early mornings make it possible for Napa's vintners to cultivate a wide range of European grape varieties. The Mayacamas Hills to the western border of the county and the Vaca range to the east contribute to its climate. The county's year-round agriculture has created a local culture that appreciates seasonal food, and Napa County growers, vintners and chefs are among the leaders in the development of the style dubbed 'California Cuisine'.


